REGULATIONS.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for annual payments, fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept 6 weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week. Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed 1 week longer. A Book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES.—One cent per volume must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid.

No member can lend any book belonging to the Library.

ANNUAL REPORT

OE THE

TRUSTEES

OF THE

NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

Presented to the Members of the Corporation at their Annual Meeting on April 30, 1861, as prescribed by the By-Laws of the Institution:

THE Trustees of the New York Society Library for the present year, feel themselves authorized to congratulate their constituents on the general state of the trust committed to their charge, and the improvement of the establishment during the past year. They still must regret that the property and income, and literary resources of this venerable institution are by no means commensurate with the wealth and magnitude of the city, nor with the means of intellectual instruction and gratification which the Library offers to the public; nevertheless, it is a just subject of congratulation, that the beginning of the eightyeighth year of our corporate existence finds the Society quite free from debt, owning a large, commodious and handsome building, on ground admirably situated, and of probably increasing value, with an extensive library, and the useful and attractive appendage of reading-rooms, amply supplied with the publications of the daily and periodical press.

The number of shareholders paying annual dues has been somewhat increased during the year, though their further augmentation has probably been lessened by the disturbed state of public affairs. The supply of American and foreign literary and scientific periodical literature has been enlarged during the year, and the Library has received many valuable additions, greater in number than it has received for some years.

This city has within a few years become one of the great book-marts of the world, not only for the publications of the American press, but for older publications of all kinds and all ages and countries, thrown upon the market by the dispersion and sale of libraries, and booksellers' stock, etc., here and in Europe. The Library Committee of this board have carefully and constantly availed themselves of such opportunities to fill up at moderate cost many chasms in the catalogue of works of English literature, biography, and travels, published during the present century, but never reprinted in this country. The usual supply of the publications of the day, English and American, has also been kept up, together with that of the best current literature from the Paris press, and some German and Italian works. Besides the purchase of most original American publications of the year, pains have been taken to fill up the deficiencies in general local American history and biography, in which departments the Library is becoming quite rich. Although far the greater number of these purchases were of works suited to the demands of the general reader, some valuable additions have been made in works of high science and ancient learning.

Donations of books to the amount of 165 volumes, were also received, for which the Library is indebted to the following donors :

The collection of pamphlets has also been increased by many donations, and the whole series of unbound ones, sorted, classified, catalogued, arranged, and labelled, so as to make the entire mass easy of examination and consultation. The utility of such a collection in a public library, is proved by the frequent inquiries and consultations of others than our own members.

Additional contributions of such tracts now scattered abroad among individuals, who regard them as nearly worthless, especially of reports, journals, documents, etc., whether political, theological, or scientific, are earnestly requested.

The present collection is the gradual and almost accidental accumulation of above sixty years. It may easily be now made in a still greater degree a body of information of incalculable value for many purposes of research, as well as of great interest and entertainment to the general reader.

The arrangements for making the library, and its supply of newspapers, magazines, reviews, etc., available and attractive to the ladies, have been continued, and it is hoped that means will be found to improve this department still more.

The materials for a new catalogue, or at least of a supplementary volume to that of 1850, are still in progress of preparation. It is hoped that the Trustees will not be prevented by limited means from carrying this design into execution next year.

The following condensed statement shows an abstract of the Receipts and Expenditures of the year, from April 1, 1860, the details of which will be found more at large in the Treasurer's Report, and that of the Auditing Committee, which are submitted with the present Report.

The balance in the Treasurer's hands consists chiefly of the sums forming the commencement of a permanent fund, from the amounts paid for commutation of the annual dues, according to a late resolution of the Trustees. Under these circumstances, the Trustees again urge upon their fellow citizens the conclusions expressed by them last year.

The New York Society Library being quite free from debt, owning also the well situated lots and excellent building which it occupies, with a library of above 50,000 volumes, peculiarly fitted for the foundation of a still more extensive collection, and receiving a considerable regular income from its present shareholders, quite adequate to all ordinary expenses of a much larger establishment; it is evident that every addition to its means, whether from the liberality of some public benefactor, or even the subscription of single members, will tend immediately, and with no loss or deduction, to the benefit of every individual contributor, and the public advantage.

The Trustees therefore earnestly recommend the Institution to the notice of their fellow citizens.
