REGULATIONS.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for annual payments, fines, etc., may take out one work, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept 6 weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week. Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed 1 week longer. A Book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

Fines.—One cent per volume must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid.

No member can lend any book belonging to the Library.

ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

TRUSTEES

OF THE

NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

THE Trustees of the New York Society Library, in obedience to the By-Law prescribing that a Report of the affairs and condition of this Corporation shall be presented to the members thereof at their Annual Meeting, respectfully submit the fol-

lowing Report:

In their Annual Report for the year ending in April, 1862, the Trustees, whilst they stated with regret that the venerable and useful Institution under their charge had not escaped from sharing some of the effects of the disturbed condition of our public affairs, which they had experienced in diminished income and an abridgment of their ordinary means, yet confidently assured the Corporation that these losses were not serious, nor such as to affect the permanent interests and future prospects of the Library. The experience of another year, similar in many respects to the last, has confirmed this confidence. income of the Institution from rents is still much below that of preceding years, but its receipts from annual dues and other sources have considerably exceeded those of the year last preceding, whilst the valuable property of the Society remains quite unencumbered, and all the debts for current expenses were settled up to the end of the present fiscal year. Thus the Corporation is quite free from debt, owning in fee a valuable, commodious and elegant building, with ample ground space for air, light or future enlargement, and a large and useful Library.

The Library has been increased above a thousand volumes, whilst the reading-rooms have been well supplied with all the

best American and Foreign Periodicals and Journals, literary, scientific and artistic, and a large number of the most important

newspapers of America and Europe.

The value and popularity of this branch of the establishment have been attested both by the increasing attendance of the Shareholders and by the augmentation of the number of Temporary Subscribers, which has nearly doubled. It is also a gratifying evidence of the utility of the Library and the estimation in which it is held, that above five thousand more volumes were taken from it for circulation among the shareholders and their families than in the year preceding, which however had been considerably in advance of any prior year in this respect. The Library has also been much consulted, both by our members and others, for purposes of study or inquiry.

A considerable saving has been effected by the collection of the annual dues of Members by the ordinary employes of the Institution without the expense of a special collector; and this collection has been very thorough, the amount of uncollected arrears being much less than usual. Twelve new shares have

been added during the year.

The following comparative statement shows the gross receipts of the last fiscal year from all sources as compared with those of the year preceding:

To these gains on the last year may be added the saving of about \$400 heretofore paid for the expense of collection, now

made (as above stated) by our own officers.

The increased cost of books and imported periodicals has, however, much restricted the Trustees in their additions to the Library. The Reading Room has been kept supplied as usual, with the diminution only of two or three foreign journals, seldom read or consulted; but the cost of such supply has been considerably increased. The additions during the year to the Library consist chiefly of English and French books in popular demand, with a prompt supply of all American new publications, whether original or reprints. But the Library Committee have found themselves restricted by limited income and high prices from the purchase of many of the more expensive works of art and science, published in Europe within a few years, in which their collection is deficient.
