ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
TRUSTEES
OF THE
NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

THE Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to the shareholders the following account of the management of the Institution during the year ending on the last day of March, 1882, with an accompanying statement of the present condition, value, and form of investment of the Society's funds.

It is with a feeling of satisfaction that the Trustees' report, as it will afford pleasure to the shareholders to learn, that every dollar of donation made to the Society is securely invested, and bringing a good interest.

Measures have been taken during the year by the Library Committee, under the direction of the Board, to provide for the comfort and convenience of the visitors to the Library; and to meet more fully the wants of readers, a suggestion book has been provided that members may enter the titles of new books which they desire to read. A special attendant has been placed in charge of the "Green Alcove," so that its treasures may be always open for inspection or consultation. In consequence of a serious accident to the Librarian, by which he was temporarily disabled, a second assistant was appointed; and in order to insure prompt delivery of books to members as well as to give further aid in the reading room another attendant was added. By this increase of the working force of the Library it is believed that much greater facilities will be afforded in the use of both books and periodicals.

For the information of the shareholders the Trustees caused to be printed in pamphlet form, the Charter and Laws relating to the Library, the by-laws and lists of the shareholders and Trustees, and directed that copies be distributed to the members.

From the income of the "John C. Green" fund, \$720.53 have been spent for the purchase of works on Art added to the "Green Alcove," and \$739.65 for the purchase of books in general literature for the Library. The balances go to increase the purchases for the ensuing year.

While the whole income of the Institution is not large and greatly needs increase from additional donations, yet from that moderate amount a considerable sum must be withdrawn for the binding of reviews, magazines and papers, and to provide additional shelving made necessary by the steady additions to our collections. Notwithstanding all drawbacks, about one thousand volumes, among them many good and valuable books, have been purchased during the past year.

The Treasurer's Report will show the receipts and expenditures for the year, and the Report of the Auditing Committee will give in detail the gifts and legacies made to the Library, and the securities held by the Trustees for the same. The previously unoccupied part of the Chatham street property has been leased, at a ground rent of \$2,500 per annum, besides all taxes and assessments, for a term of twenty-one years from March 1st, 1882, with covenants of renewal as usual in building leases. It is intended to set aside this ground-rent as the income of the "John C. Green Fund." The other property in Chatham street produces a gross rental of \$2,675, from which taxes and other expenses must be deducted. The probable net rent will be about \$1,815, for the next fiscal year, and this will, it is likely, be increased in future years. The interest on the above investment will be a little over 6½ per cent.

Regulations.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consist of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept 6 weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week.

Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed 1 week longer. A Book may be again taken out, unless another Member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
