ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

TRUSTEES

OF THE

NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees report that for the year ending March 31st, 1884, the receipts from all sources have been.....	\$12,969 57
Of which there has been received for annual dues and other usual sources of income.....	4,971 91
For rent of room in the Library Building (11 months).....	458 26
For rent of Chatham street real estate.....	5,271 49
Showing an increase from rents during the year of	302 88

From the rents of the Chatham Street real estate, \$2,500 has been set apart for the income of the "John C. Green fund," one-half of which, by the terms of the donation, is to be expended in the purchase and binding of books of art for the "Green alcove," and the other half in the purchase of works in general literature, exclusive of fiction.

Of the income from this fund, there is on hand at the close of the year \$1,565.07, to be used for the first purpose, and \$409.03 available for the purchase of works of general literature during the coming year. The number of volumes added to the Library during the year has been 1,309, and 21,930 volumes have been taken out by 13,095 readers. The number of shareholders and temporary subscribers to the Library during the year has been about the same as the preceding year, and no large increase can be expected until better facilities to use the Library can be offered to residents of the upper part of the city, the Library being no longer convenient of access to most of its shareholders, and of that class of citizens for whom it was originally designed.

For the same reason, and because of the increased cheapness and wider diffusion of newspapers and periodicals, there continues to be a falling off in the number of those who resort to the Reading Room. It is therefore becoming a question of importance whether some considerable portion of the present expenditure upon the Reading Room

could not be used to greater advantage in providing an office further up town for the distribution of books.

During the year the Library has been presented by Mr. Charles H. Contoit, of this city, with the costly and now quite rare Folio Edition of "Audubon's Birds of America," with a handsome book case containing it; a gift which merits this public mention and acknowledgment.

The visitors to the "Green alcove" continue to increase in number, and its value to the public, as well to the shareholders and subscribers, is shown by its constant use by those who resort there for study and for designs in many departments of manufacture.

As this alcove is now filled with the costly works, for the reception of which it was arranged and decorated, it is proposed to fit up an adjoining alcove, in connection with the present one, and for the same purposes. To enable the Library to do this without trenching on its other resources, the donor of the "Green" fund has offered to release the restrictions upon its income to such an extent that the portion devoted to the acquisition of works of art shall be applied to the cost of the new alcove.

The Trustees have recently collected the duplicate books which are of no further use in the Library, and they are now exposed and offered for sale within the building, at very moderate prices put upon them by a dealer in old books. Among these books are some of value and rarity, to which the Trustees call the attention of the shareholders and others, that they may avail themselves of the opportunity to purchase, before those volumes which are not sold at the Library are disposed of to dealers or at auction.

Persons not Members or Subscribers have the privilege of consultation by the payment of 25 cents.

Regulations.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consist of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week.

Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
