## ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

TRUSTEES

OF THE

## New York Society Library.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to its shareholders the following report of the condition of the Institution at the close of the fiscal year, on the 31st of March, 1885.

From the report of the Treasurer and that of the Auditing Committee, which are herewith also submitted, it appears that The Receipts during the year from all sources have been
$\$ 14,220.59$
(an increase of $\$ 1,35092$ from the preceding year)
Of which there has been received from annual dues and other usual sources of income
$5,176.75$
(an increase from last year of $\$ 20484$ )
From rents of Chatham St. real estate, and rent of room in the Library Building.

(an increase of $\$ 120.25$ more than last year.)
The increase in the receipts during the present year is further accounted for by the sales of about 560 volumes of duplicate books, (leaving about 1,000 volumes yet to be sold) for....

There remains in the Treasury from the general fund available
for the current expenses of the Library.
1,625.21
From the income of the "John C. Green" memorial fund.... 698.58 of which $\$ 185.76$ is dedicated to the purchase of books for the Green alcove, and $\$ 512.82$ can be used for the purchase of books for circulation, except works of fiction.

The additions to the Library during the year have been about 1,000 volumes.

The number of volumes given out among subscribers and shareholders and others using the Library, remains about the same as during the preceding year, while there has been a slight increase in the number of those who frequent the reading room.

During the year a portion of the income from the Green endowment, has, with the consent of the donor, been expended in fitting up an adjoining alcove, as a much needed addition to the former "Green Alcove." The shelving has been more than doubled, and sufficient room and light for the more convenient accomodation of those who resort to these alcoves for study and work has been thus obtained. The value of this rare collection of books in art and design is shown by the increasing use that is made of it by the student and manufacturer, as its existence and the fact that admission to it is free to those who need its advantages in their profession and business, becomes more extensively known.

Another direct result from this endowment is the steady elevation of the tone of the library as regards the books issued to its members, the Trustees being enabled to purchase more works of permanent value in literature for circulation than ever before in the history of the Institution. Works of fiction and other ephemeral publications are now so cheaply purchased, that it is no longer required to expend a large part of our income in supplying this class of literature, and it is believed that the Library is now much more resorted to for the profitable reading matter which it supplies than formerly.

The Trustees endeavor to give to the Institution under their charge, a high character and repute as a library for the families of its members, in every respect, and in that endeavor confidently rely upon the approval and support of the shareholders. They are fully aware that some greater facilities in the distribution of books might make the Library more accessible to its shareholders and more popular with that class of the community for which it is intended, and plans to that end have been mentioned in previous reports, but as the income of the Institution has been barely sufficient for its most economical management, they have been reluctantly compelled to postpone any change requiring increased expenditure until they can rely upon some permanent increase in the annual resources.

## Regulations.

## LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out one work, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos 3 weeks, octavos 2 weeks, duodecimos 1 week.

Members residing more than 10 miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

Fines.-One cent per volume must be paid for each day they are detained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can lend any book belonging to the Library.
