## ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

## TRUSTEES

OF THE

## New York Society Library.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit the following report of its affairs and condition at the close of the fiscal year ending March 31, 1889.

From the report of the Treasurer herewith submitted, it will be seen thatThe receipts from all sources, including the balance brought over
from last year amounted to. . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . $\$ 16,812.03$
The total Disbursements have been. . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . 11,334.05
Leaving a balance on hand of. . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . 5, 577.98
Of this amount, the sum of $\$ 3,122.08$ is the balance of income of the Green Fund,-3,267.26 being available for the purchase of books, \&c. for the "Green Alcove" and $\$ 824.82$ to be used for the purchase of works of general literature for circulation, except prose fiction.

From the balance on hand at the date of the last Annual Report two thousand dollars $(\$ 2,000.00)$ have been transferred to the permanent fund $\$ 1,000.00$ having been loaned on Bond and Mortgage on Real Estate in East 4th St., and $\$ 1,000.00$ temporarily deposited in the Manhattan Savings Institution.

Two hundred and fifty dollars paid in during the year for commutation of Annual dues have been added to the Commutation Fund, which now amounts to $\$ 1,200.00$, thus making an increase during the year in the permanent funds of the Library of $\$ 2,250.00$.

The amount of the tax upon the Library Building paid in 1886 has, through the efficient action of Mr. Baldwin, our Secretary and Counsel, been recovered and returned to the Library by the city authorities.

There has been a slight increase in the number of visitors to the Reading Room.

The number of books added to the Library during the year was 724 and the number of volumes circulated was about the same as in the preceding year.

To the "Fine Arts Department," founded and endowed by Mrs. Sarah H. Green, a superb collection of large Photographs of the paintings of the old Italian Masters, and of some of the most celebrated architectural monuments of Italy, bound up in 12 folio volumes, has been added, by the generous gift of Henry A. Cram, Esq.

If some other liberal friend of the Library would enable the Library Committee to add the series of Photographs of the contents of the great European galleries now being taken, this department would possess a collection unequalled in this country.

While the Trustees are fully aware of the obstacles to the growth and prosperity of the Library, arising from its present location, so far removed from the residences of many of its members, they do not deem it wise to undertake a removal until the Society is in possession of the means necessary to meet the great expense which must be incurred, nor until there is a decision of certain questions, now under public discussion, which should influence the selection of a new location.

It is interesting to note in this centennial year that in 1789 the legislature of this state passed an act reviving and confirming the royal charter granted to this institution in 1772 -the events of the revolutionary war having for many years prevented the meeting of the Trustees and nearly destroyed the Library.

Many of the present sbareholders still retain the rights or shares owned by their ancestors in 1789, while some shares are still held by the descendants of the original shareholders of 1754 .

## REGULATIONS.

## LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out one work, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos three weeks, octavos two weeks, duodecimos one week.

Members residing more than ten miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

Fines-One cent per volume must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for ; if a part of a set the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can lend any book belonging to the Library.
