## REGULATIONS.

Loaning of Books.-Every shareholder of or subscriber to the New York Society Library shall be allowed to take out four works at a time, of which not more than one shall be a new work.

New books may be kept one week only. Other books may be kept three weeks with the privilege of renewal, unless other members have applied for them.

Books recently purchased or for any reason in demand will be considered as new books.

Fines.-One cent per volume must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No member can lend any book belonging to the Library.

OF THE

## NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to the Shareholders the following statement of its condition for the year ending March 31,1896 :

The report of the Treasurer, presented herewith, shows the receipts from all sources during the year to have amounted to $\$ 13,807.23$, and the disbursements of all kinds to $\$ 11,972.54$, leaving a balance on hand of $\$ 1,834.69$, of which amount the sum of $\$ 1,536.03$ belongs to the income of the "Green Fund," $\$ 555.33$ to be devoted to the purchase of books for the Green Alcove, or Art Department, and $\$ 980.71$ to the purchase of books for circulation.

The net income for the last year is somewhat larger than that of the preceding one, and the expenditures, more especially for books, have been considerably larger.

No change has been made in the investment of the Library Funds ; but $\$ 600$ have been added to the Commutation Fund during the year.

Owing to deaths and removals, the number of Shareholders continues to diminish, as it has done for several years past, through forfeitures and surrender of shares, causing a constant diminution of income from annual dues. The increase from that source during the past year, over that of the preceding one, is exceptional, and is owing to the collection of several arrears.

The total number of visitors during the year was 20,500 , of whom 13,509 were ladies, and 6,991 were gentlemen. Of the visitors, 457 have called to consult the Green Alcove.

The circulation of books amounted to 27,174 , of which 16,379 were works of fiction, and was the largest in the month of January, and smallest in the month of August. A record of books consulted in the general Library, kept for the last six months, shows the number to be 2,675 . The total number of books in the Library is about 100,000 .

During the year many fine works, several of rarity and very considerable value, among which may be mentioned the Boisserée Gallery, Gravina's Il Duomo di Monreale, Vestigia delle Terme di Titi, Fischbach's Textile Ornaments, and Elliot's Birds of North America, have been added to the Alcove, and it is a matter of regret that such a rich storehouse of
art should not be used to a greater extent. A Dictionary Catalogue is now nearly finished, which will be a complete guide to its resources.

A Subject Catalogue of the general Library, without which the resources of any library are to a large extent unavailable, is also being prepared, and will be of great value as an index to the material we have on any subject.

The tracing of family history is now pursued with interest by many members, and the lack of genealogies and of local histories is to be regretted. Increased funds for this purpose, and for the general enlargement of the Library, are much needed, and its friends could do a most useful service by supplying the need. An effort on the part of Shareholders to secure new Shareholders and Subscribers to the Library would also be of advantage in securing the same end.

An accumulation of several hundred duplicates of books no longer needed by the Library were placed on the long table, marked to be sold at low prices-thus giving our members the benefits of the low rates and at the same time making a return to the Library. The opportunity seemed to be appreciated, and about one-half of such duplicates have been sold thus far.

The Trustees take pleasure in expressing their appreciation of the generosity and interest in the Library shown in the gifts by Mrs. Amelia B. Lazarus of many works of art for the Alcove; by Mrs. Catharine L. Olmsted of several sumptuously bound and extra illustrated books; and also by the numerous gifts of Mr. Clarence Cook. The gift of the late Mr. Cram has been generously completed by his family, who have sent to the Library eight volumes of photographs of the Paintings by the Old Masters of Italy. This collection now comprises about three thousand examples, and is one of the most extensive and important of its class in this country.

Last spring Mr. Butler, the Librarian, whose health had become much impared, asked to be relieved from a portion of the active duties of his office. His long, faithful and useful service to the Library entitled him to such relief, and accordingly Mr. Frank B. Bigelow, for three years Assistant Librarian at Columbia College, was appointed Acting Librarian -becoming Librarian on the first day of October last. Mr. Butler thereupon became Librarian Emeritus, and will continue to render his valuable services to the Library as far as his health may permit.

The problem of accessibility of the Library Building still remains to be solved. The residential centre of the city seems to be moving further and further up town. Many of our Shareholders state that they are led to make use of other libraries, because of the distance of our building from their homes. The question presses itself upon us with increasing seriousness of either a removal up town, or of the establishment of a branch or branches in the upper part of the city.
