## REGULATIONS.

**Lending.**—Every shareholder of or subscriber to the New York Society Library shall be allowed to take out *four* works at a time, of which not more than one shall be a new work.

New books may be kept one week only. Other books may be kept three weeks, with the privilege of renewal, unless other members have applied for them.

Books recently purchased or for any reason in demand will be considered as new books.

**Fines.**—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid for; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No member shall *lend* any books belonging to the library.

The annual dues of shareholders should be paid *by cheque* to the order of the Treasurer.

Temporary subscribers are required, at the time of subscription, to sign the customary agreement in the "Subscribers' Book." The Librarian will give a receipt for each subscription.

Payments should be made to the Librarian for fines, books lost, expressage, postage, etc., and receipts will be furnished by him in the name of the Treasurer at the time of payment.



# ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

## TRUSTEES OF THE NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

---

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to the shareholders the following statement of its condition for the year ending March 31, 1906.

The report of the Treasurer, presented herewith, shows that the receipts from all sources have amounted during the year to \$43,312.60, and the disbursements of all kinds (exclusive of investments of \$36,000), to \$14,141.95. Of the receipts, \$27,511.28 should be credited to capital and \$13,739.31 to income, irrespective of the income of the Green Fund, which amounted to \$2,062.01.

The total number of persons using the Library during the year ending March 31, 1906, was 24,234, of whom 8,213 were men, and the total number of volumes drawn was 31,497. The circulation of books was largest in January, 1906, and smallest in August, 1905. The books relating to the Fine Arts in the Green Alcoves were used by 262 men and 502 women.

There were sent into the country, by mail and express, 596 parcels of books, nearly one-third more than the previous year. From April 1, 1905, to March 31, 1906, our messengers carried 26,619 books, visiting 8,979 places located between No. 1 Broadway and 145th Street, showing that 5,000 more books were carried and above 2,000 more places were visited than the previous year.

The Library is now in the soundest and most flourishing condition financially that it has ever been, and owing to the liberality of its management, it is not excelled in advantages offered to its members by any similar institution in the country. Our annual subscriptions are over one-third larger than any recorded,



the largest previous record (with the exception of last year) having been in 1865. There is a considerable constituency in a wealthy city like New York for a library conducted with cordial co-operation between the members and the management. Our members have been so well pleased with the prompt service of the books and the privileges afforded them, that many have introduced their friends, with a corresponding demand upon our facilities, in order to maintain a prompt and satisfactory service. Communication with our members, however, is easily effected by means of the mail, telephone and free delivery of books.

The members are indebted to Mrs. J. R. Brodhead for a further gift this year of 300 valuable unbound volumes, among them being "Van der Donck's Beschryvinge von Nieuwv Nederland, 1656," with the very rare map; "Moulton's New York 170 Years Ago," an extremely scarce pamphlet, with map of New York in 1673; and "Asher's Bibliographical and Historical Essay on Dutch Books and Pamphlets relating to New Netherland"; from Mrs. Fanny Schermerhorn Bridgham were received 482 pamphlets, largely scientific, sociological and geographical; from Miss Laura Hoe 47 numbers of the Eclectic Magazine, in continuation of a previous gift; from Dr. F. Spencer Halsey 34 volumes of Americana, and from Dr. T Matlack Cheesman a copy of the New York Society Library catalogue of 1813. Although the Library already had two copies, both of them lacked the list of members, which makes this copy especially valuable to the Society Library.

The Trustees record with great regret the loss of Frederic J. de Peyster, Esq., who died May 10, 1905. He was elected a Trustee of the Library in 1874. The de Peyster family were among the petitioners to King George the Third for establishing the Society Library in 1754, and their name appears among the original subscribers. The different branches of the family have owned several shares each and have always been among its most loyal supporters.
