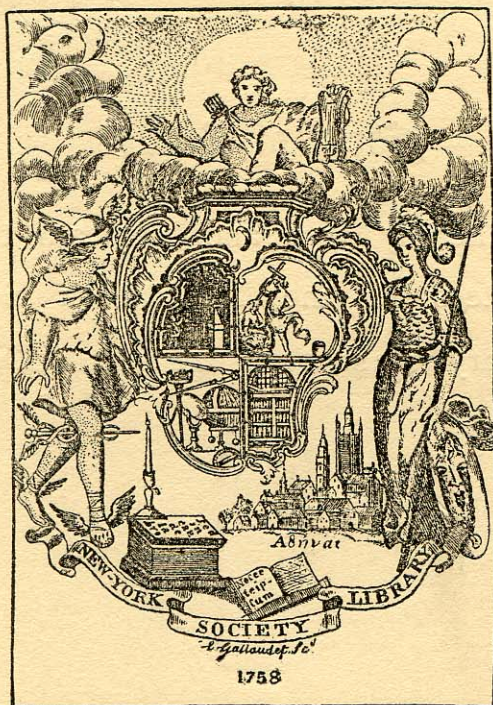

## REGULATIONS.

1.—Every member who shall not be indebted to the Corporation for any annual payment, or for fines or forfeitures incurred by him or her, and whose name shall be entered in the Treasurer's Register, shall, for every right owned by him or her, be entitled to receive from the Librarian, during the hours appointed for the Library to be open, *four* works at a time, of which not more than one shall be a new work.

New books may be kept one week only. Other books may be kept three weeks, with the privilege of renewal, unless other members have applied for them.

2.—The ownership of a share shall not give the privileges of the Library to more than *one* person and to his or her *household*.

If the ownership is vested in an estate or corporation, the privileges shall be restricted to such person and to his or her immediate household as may be designated by the executors of the estate or by the corporation.

3.—No person, whether member or not, shall lend any book belonging to the corporation to any person out of his dwelling-house.

4.—Any member who shall detain a book longer than the times above limited, respectively, shall forfeit and pay for every day such book shall be detained beyond the time so limited, one cent.

5.—If any member lose or damage a book, he shall make good the same to the Library; and if the book lost or injured be one of a set, he shall pay, to the Treasurer, for the use of the corporation, the value of the entire set, and may thereupon receive for himself the residue of the whole set.

6.—The Librarian may let out books to persons not being members of the corporation, upon such terms and conditions as shall from time to time be prescribed by the Library Committee. But, if a member and a person who is not a member, should apply for the same book at the same time, the member shall have the preference.

7.—A member, besides the books he may be entitled to as a member, may take as many as he pleases on the same terms as persons who are not members.



# ANNUAL REPORT

## OF THE

# TRUSTEES OF THE NEW YORK SOCIETY

# LIBRARY.

---

The Trustees of the New York Society Library present to the members this their report for the year ending March 31, 1912.

The Treasurer's report hereto appended, and to which attention is invited, shows a small but gratifying excess of receipts over expenditures.

The Trustees are constantly striving to meet changing conditions and to give to the patrons of the Library the best possible service. To this end, the practice of delivering books to members at their residences, without charge, was instituted in 1904. The territory covered by such distribution, at first very limited, has been increased from year to year, so that now it covers Manhattan Island as far north as 160th Street, and extends south into Brooklyn. At present, the majority of the members order their books by post or telephone. At the request of many members, books are selected and forwarded to them periodically by the librarian. We believe that ours is the only Library which has a free delivery system. To localities too remote to permit of such free delivery, books are shipped to members by express. The express charges for delivery and return of the books are paid at the Library and the member's account is charged with the amount. By these methods, with the least possible inconvenience to our members, our books are at their disposal wherever they may happen to be, and a visit to the Library for access to its literary treasures has become a matter of choice, rather than of necessity.

The rare books, some of which are almost priceless in value, can, of course, only be consulted within the Library walls. That these works may be appreciated, and regard and respect for our



venerable institution may be preserved and fostered, it is the hope of the Trustees that the members will find it for their interest and pleasure to visit the Library building whenever inclination and convenience may permit.

Owing to a happy accident, booklovers may now find at the Library a volume containing a part of Bradford's Prayer-book of 1710, the first prayer-book published in this country, of which the only known perfect copy is in the possession of the Pennsylvania Historical Society. The pages of this work to which reference is made were recently found among the pages of an ancient volume which was being prepared for rebinding. They are in good preservation and were identified by our Secretary, Mr. Beverly Chew.

For the past three years, the Library has been buying at auction and at private sale, books and pamphlets relating to the War of 1812, as favorable opportunity is offered. We now have a fairly representative collection, and will gratefully appreciate any additions to it which our members may be willing to contribute.

During the year many valuable gifts have been made to the Library. To Mr Beverly Chew, Colonel Theodore Roosevelt, The New York Evening Post, Mr J. W Vroom, Miss Drisler, Mrs. G. A. Lung, Miss A. M. Vail, the Reverend Henry Anstice, Mr. H. E. Gregory, Mr. J M. Knox, Mr Howland Pell, and the many other ladies and gentlemen to whom for these gifts the Library is indebted, the Trustees take this opportunity to make their grateful acknowledgment.

The Library Committee, as opportunity serves and funds permit, are adding to the art books of the Green Alcove. Numerous purchases of rare and standard books and books of reference have been made during the year, well worthy of inspection and study.

Upon the whole, the Trustees feel that good use has been made during the past year of the resources at their command. They feel justified in believing that the year upon which the Library is about to enter will be one of usefulness and progress.

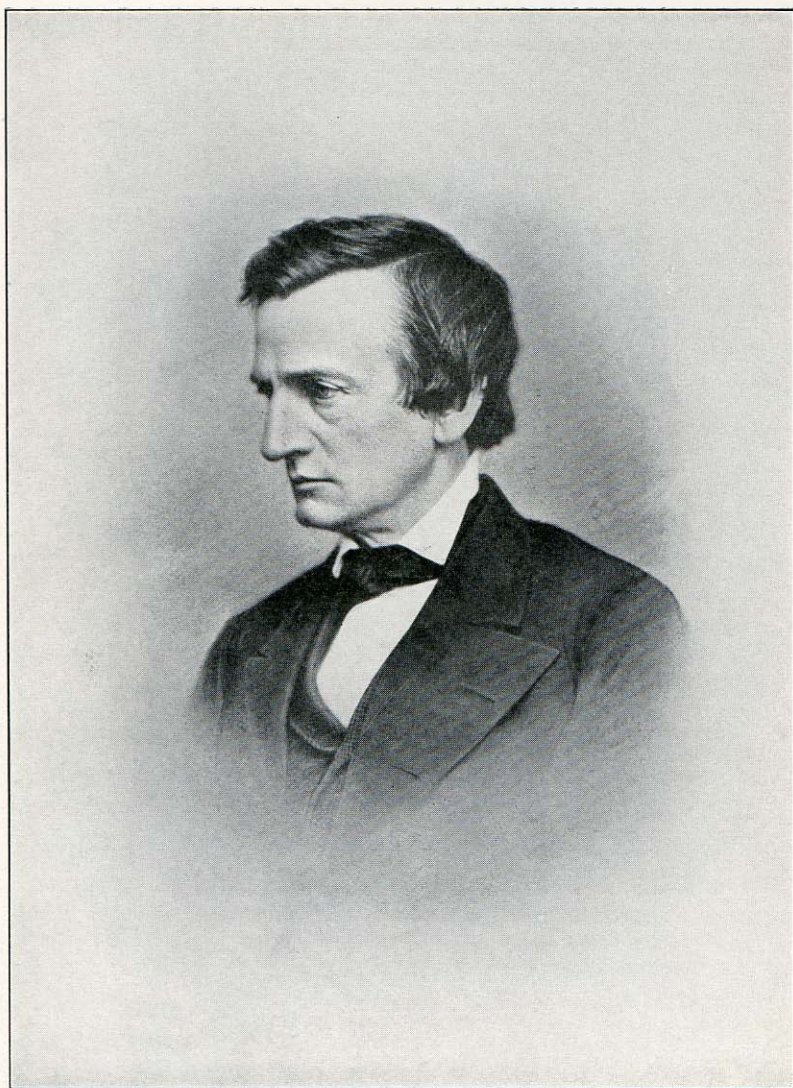

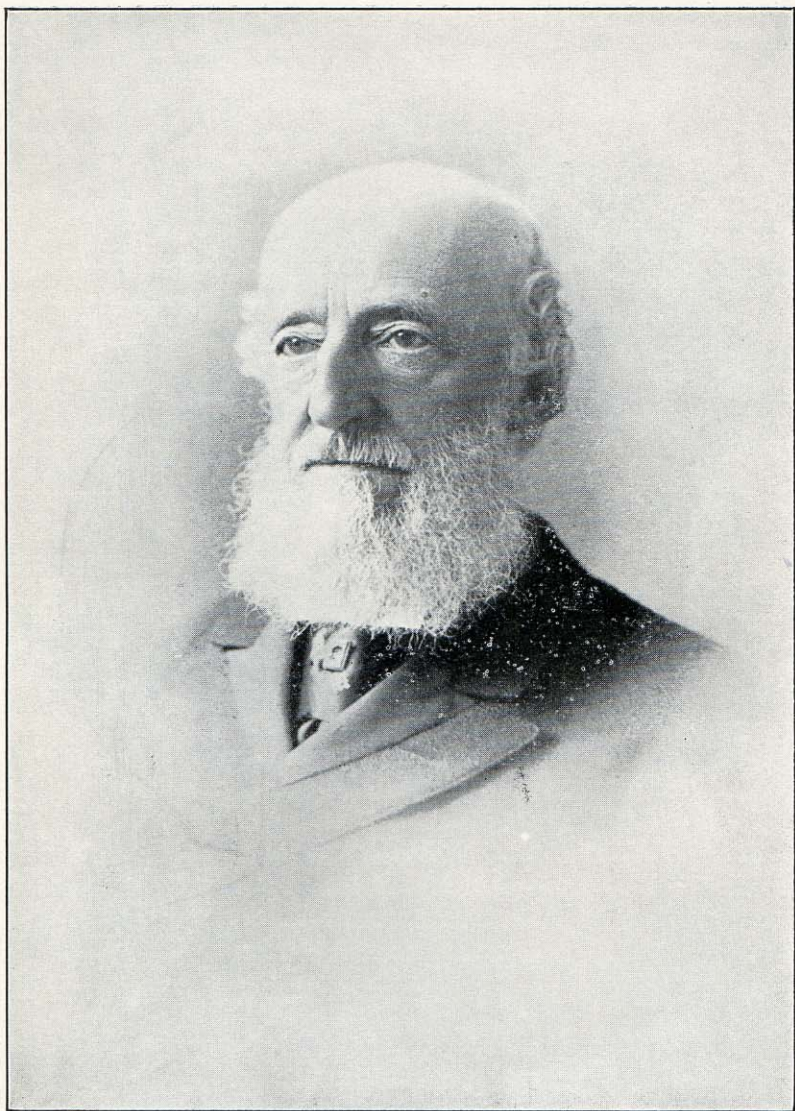
