ANNUAL REPORT

THE TRUSTEES OF THE NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY respectfully submit to the Shareholders their Annual Report of the condition of its affairs for the year ending on the last day of March 1890.

During the year there has been no change in the Trustees or the employees.

The Report of the Treasurer herewith presented shows the receipts from all sources to have amounted to \$15,712.23 and the disbursements \$11,485.25 leaving a balance on hand of \$4,226.98.

Of this amount the sum of \$2,348.98 is the balance of income of the "Green Fund," \$1,236.02 being available for the purchase of books, &c., for the "Green Alcove," or Art Department, and \$1,112.96 to be used for the purchase and binding of books of general literature except prose fiction.

From the income of the general funds during the past year, one thousand dollars have been transferred to the permanent funds, being temporarily deposited in the Manhattan Savings Institution, awaiting investment. The amounts invested on Bond and Mortgage remain the same as at the close of the previous fiscal year.

The Reading Room has been much frequented at certain hours of the day, but the circulation of books is but little, if any, larger than during the preceding year, the library, in this respect, sharing the fortune of other subscription and shareholding libraries in places where libraries have been established and endowed from public or private funds. To this cause must be added the present location of our Library building which, though convenient of access from all quarters has now become far removed from the residences of the great majority of that portion of the community from which its patrons must be recruited.

There have been added to the Fine Arts Department during the year past, the most valuable productions of the Art Literature of the year in various modern languages, besides many important productions of the past.

A system is being pursued that will hereafter bring to this department the principal works in every branch of Art, so that each will be fully represented. For instance recently a number of the best illustrated works on Greek Vases have been received and ordered, a branch hitherto unrepresented, so too have been added reproductions of drawings of the old Masters and books on early prints.

This system carried out, will make this Department, now one of the best, superior to all others.

The existing catalogue of the Art collection made many years ago, originally was imperfect and incorrect. A new catalogue, complete and correct, is being prepared and will in the course of the spring be ready for the printer.

## REGULATIONS.

### LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out *one work*, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos three weeks, octavos two weeks, duodecimos one week.

Members residing more than ten miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid; if a part of a set the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
