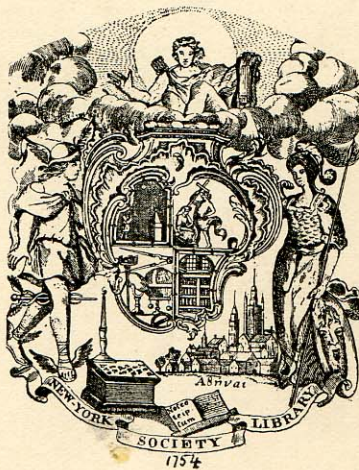

ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
TRUSTEES
OF THE
NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to the Shareholders the following statement of its condition for the year ending March 31st, 1894:

The Report of the Treasurer herewith presented shows the receipts to have amounted to \$13,850.26, and the disbursements to \$12,032.36, leaving a balance on hand of \$1,817.90. Of this amount the sum of \$1,817.68 belongs to the Income of the "Green Fund," \$529.05 to be devoted to the purchase of books for the "Green Alcove," or Art department, and \$1,288.63 for books for circulation.

The net income of the last year is a little less than that of the preceding year, but the expenditures have been larger by nearly \$1,000, owing to higher rates of insurance.

No change has been made in the investment of the Library funds.

While there has been little change in the number of Shareholders and subscribers, the circulation of books has much increased, being several thousand more than in the preceding year. The circulation for 1893 was 27,005 volumes.

The number of visitors to the Library during the year 1893 was nearly 20,000, of whom two-thirds were ladies. The number consulting the Green Alcove has increased this year, as it did in the last. In the 23 working days of February there were 106 visitors, of whom 54 were artists or students of art.

A larger income for this department of the Library is needed, and it is hoped that some of the wealthy patrons of the Library may remember our needs, and enable us to purchase the many expensive works on art now issuing from the press.

The Trustees are not unmindful of the advantages of moving the Library to a situation farther up town—whenever such a change becomes practicable. It is believed that the inconvenience of the present location may be largely remedied by the employment of messengers to carry out and

bring back books ordered by mail. This plan adopted a year or two ago has only recently become generally known to our members and is growing in favor daily. During the last year more than 1,300 volumes have been delivered at the residences of members—twice as many as in 1892. In the 23 working days of February last 487 volumes were sent out and called for from 36 Broadway to 129th Street and West End Avenue at a charge of 10 cents.

Since the last Annual Meeting the Library has been most unfortunate in the death of four of its Trustees: Mr. RICHARD T. AUCHMUTY, Mr. EDWARD SCHELL, Mr. JOHN M. KNOX and Mr. HENRY A. CRAM. Mr. Schell had been a member of the Board since 1872, and its Treasurer since 1880; Mr. Auchmuty was elected in 1876; Mr. Knox, who was Chairman of the Board for some years, in 1879, and Mr. Cram in 1888.

The "Green Alcove" has been under the sole charge of Mr. Cram, and is indebted to him for the gift of a valuable collection of photographs of the paintings of the old Italian Masters, and of some of the most celebrated architectural monuments of Italy.

All four of these gentlemen took a keen interest in the welfare of the Library, and were constant and faithful in the discharge of their duty as Trustees.

REGULATIONS.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out *two works*, if they consist of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos three weeks, octavos two weeks, duodecimos one week, new books one week for each volume.

Members residing more than ten miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid; if a part of a set, the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
