#### William Rose Benet (1948):

Either my memory is at fault or there is one essay that neither Charles Lamb, William Hazlitt, nor Christopher Morley ever wrote: one on Reference Books. The phrase for them, now cliché, has been "mines of information". But a mine, at best, is a rather dark and dreary excavation – not to say *dank*, at times.

I prefer to think of the book before you as a cave like the famous one stumbled upon by Aladdin. I might go on from there to describe its revelation of treasure of so many varieties and kinds, yet each in its own particular bin. For the office of a reference book is, after all, to bring some order out of chaos. But it is also to present you a well-organized supplementary memory, in one volume.

The delights of such memory may be inexhaustible; the safaris of research it can initiate, endless; the urge to literary creation which it can supply, present on every page. And remember, that to enter this domain of learning and imagination you have not even to use the mysterious phrase, "Open Sesame!"

## What is a reference source?

- Book used to find information on a subject or topic
- Book used to identify other sources of information on a subject or topic
- More broadly, any title in the Reference location!
- You can tell a reference book by its call number (starts with "Ref." or "Large")
- Focus today on selected print resources and their companion electronic versions
- Resources available here at NYSL
- Print collection has 1700 volumes
- More e-resources are at public libraries
- List is a selection of titles, not all we have!

## Why use a reference book first?

- Help define vocabulary for a topic
- · Overview and main issues of topic
- Currency of information
- Scholarly credibility of author(s)
- Reputable publishing company is behind it
- Suggested references to read further (this can be a great time saver for you!)

## A reference collection will reflect...

- Ways to access the local collection
- Membership of the institution
  - -> (e.g. literature, history, health)
- Questions asked at the NYSL desk
- Choices of the librarians / Library staff
- Budget and space that is available
- Are titles at another library nearby?

# Where do outdated editions go?

- Some will be archived in the Library stacks or closed stacks
- "Latest edition only" in the Library catalog → we discard the previous one!
- Main Issue: the currency of information → the old information can be misleading

# How to identify the right reference source?

- Reference and Circulation staff
- Browse using call number ranges

- (handout: "Guide to the Stacks")
- Advice from people you know ("oh, just use the ANB for that!")
- References in other books
- Online catalog for the Library

# Some Tips...

- Scan table of contents and scope of book
- You need to be in the right source! > e.g. Current Biography vs. American National Biography (ANB)
- Index

## Chronological coverage

- Paper supplements
   e.g. Fiction catalog, Reader's guide to periodical literature
- Ongoing volumes published

# More Tips....

- Commonly referred to as....
   e.g. Peterson's; Sargent's; DNB; Bartlett's
- Older editions of reference books available in Stacks location
- "Split" years holdings
  - > some in Reference, some in Stacks
- Electronic versions of some titles > e.g. Oxford Reference Online
- Notice something that we don't have?
